Materials And Tools



You will need the following items from a large Haberdashery Store.

MATERIALS:

1. A round base measuring 10cm. in diameter with a comb attached underneath. (In Australia, Spotlight sells them. See handy hints if you are not able to find one.)
2. One, 11cm square of fabric, the same as your outfit or in a colour that tones in with it, or perhaps the colour of your accessories. Take part of your outfit with you when matching your fabric and feathers.
3. One bunch of Biot/Goose spikes in a colour that will pick up the same colour, or one of the colours from your outfit. You may like to have two different colours, like I have in mine.
4. Sixteen stripped coque tail feathers, the same as above. A mix is very eye catching.
5. 1/4 of a metre of marabou in a colour that tones in with every thing.
6. 30cm of thin velvet ribbon 1/2 cm wide, it will not be seen under the base so you choose a colour.

TOOLS:

Scissors, Pencil, Kettle with a spout (optional).

Hot Glue Gun with a trigger. (borrow one perhaps)

1 clear glue stick.

Craft glue, I use 450 clear glue.
